4. Action Items

 Cari and Connie nominated Angela Woodall to continue as Chair and Ruth Fletcher-Carter to continue as Vice-Chair of the LCMC. LCMC members approved the nominations.

5. Presentations

Transfort Bus Stop ADA Upgrades – Melina Dempsey, Transfort Transit Planner, presented on the Bus Stop ADA program. Transfort currently has nearly 450 stops and the agency is working to ensure all of them are accessible. The program started in 2016 and hope to complete the program by 2026. The program is funded through the Building on Basics (BOB) sales tax, Keep Fort Collins Great sales tax, and through other City funds – this leads to about \$325,000 per year. To build a pad, it costs \$10,000 and all improvements cost \$20,000. This leads to about 33 stops being upgraded per year. Some stops have more issues than others, including rights-of-way. The ad agency that currently manages bus stops has reached the end of its contract period to provide additional amenities.

6. Discussion Items

 NEMT – Brabson stated 125 people attended HCPF Benefits Collaborative Meeting. HCPF is working on a new NEMT Request for Proposals. Background checks eliminated people and companies from the NEMT-eligible list. Larimer and Weld counties are facing additional transportation issues because some taxi companies have recently closed.


- Angela Loveland is holding a training event for ADA-complementary paratransit.
